Update -AP/CLEP Special Presentation by Dr. McGurk (College Board)

Dr. Sessions reviewed a spreadsheet of AP/CLEP course equivalences credits for each institution being worked on by his office.

Dr. Suzanne McGurk, Senior Director, Higher Education Policy of the College Board, presented a summary of scores for the 2022 Cohort AP exams. A copy of the presentation is available upon request.

Dr. Lewis asked if the reports were sent automatically to the institutions, and Dr. McGurk answered the reports were by request only.

Update- ACHE Initiatives and Budget

Dr. Robin McGill presented updates on the following ACHE Initiatives and Budget:

- ACHE's operating budget for FY23-24, including increased funding for the AGSC line item.
- (Re)Engage Alabama grant initiative, which will be implemented in January 2024.
- ACHE's new online interactive tool (Power BI) that will link information to each institution on recruitment, admissions and much more.
- Alabama Committee on Credential and Transparency Act
- ATLAS on Career Pathways
- Preliminary Enrollment Trends for 2023
- Updates to the Administrative Code for Program Review Regulations- changes to
 the reasonable extensions and alterations to existing units and programs of
 instruction to make more simplified, clear and aligned with SACSCOC.
 Dr. McGill was asked whether it was advisable to allow community college to add
 concentrations within their transfer associate degrees. It will reinforce structure
 already going on with AGSC. This option is not addressed in ACHE's
 administrative procedure but there is an opportunity to set up a process in
 coordination with AGSC. Dr. McGill suggested a peer review option or AGSC
 process to look into this matter. Dr. Sessions discussed putting the matter on the
 agenda for next meeting for committee input. He also asked for information in
 writing on the guide maps.

Update- Alabama Transfer Website

Mike Malley demonstrated the updates and features on the new website on usage reports. Dr. Sessions discussed the transfer submission dashboard, specifically that more information is available on how students are using the website to get transfer guides.
