## **DECISION ITEMS**

#### **ACADEMIC COMMITTEES**

<u>Academic Committee Course Recommendations</u>. Sessions presented two course proposals recommended for approval by the Academic Committees (copies attached - #3):

- Introduction to International Studies-UAB
- Physical Anthropology-USA

After some discussion, Britt moved for approval of the Political Science Academic Committee recommendation for the UAB program. Meehan seconded. Motion passed.

There was discussion regarding the USA program being accepted as a Natural Science course in Area III. The AGSC decided to table approval of the USA program until further clarification from the Academic Committee.

<u>Ratification of Templates</u>. Nash presented the following templates for ratification as recommended by the Chief Academic Officers:

- Geomatics TU
- Meteorology USA

Glaze moved for conditional approval of the Geomatics template pending clarification of the Art course. Britt seconded. Motion passed.

Glaze moved for approval of the Meteorology template. Meehan seconded. Motion passed.

Templates for Anthropology and Political Science were sent to the Academic Committees for review. No changes were made and no action was required.

#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

<u>Degree Audit Report System (DARS)</u>. Dr. Dan Osborne gave a power point demonstration of the Degree Audit Reporting System (DARS) being used at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. The automated system compares a student's coursework with the requirements for their degree and produces a report detailing their progress towards that degree.

After questions, the Committee thanked Dr. Osborne for his presentation.

# **Executive Director's Report**

<u>STARS Usage Reports</u>. Sessions reported that usage reports have been posted for November and December 2005. Usage by institution is also available in chart or pie graph format. The four-year

reports are in a new format which reflects the institution students are selecting by first and/or second choice. More detailed reports can be requested from the STARS office.

<u>STARS Staff Member</u>. Sessions stated that the STARS office is in need of an Administrative Assistant to the Executive Director. The proposed job description was discussed in addition to required qualifications (copy attached - #5). The AGSC decided that the position title should be changed to Assistant to the Executive Director and the salary be increased.

Glaze moved that a new staff member for the STARS office be pursued. Meehan seconded. Motion passed.
