The regular meeting of the Articulation and General Studies Committee was called to order at 10:15 a.m. A quorum was determined by voice roll call of members present.
Meehan moved for the adoption of the agenda as distributed. Mitchell seconded. The agenda was adopted.
Jones moved for the approval of the February 10, 2009 Minutes with corrections. Mitchell seconded. Minutes were approved with corrections.
Sessions welcomed Ms. Jackie Hundley, a visiting student from Auburn University majoring in Software Engineering. Dr. Rod Britt was presented with an award from AGSC members for his service to the AGSC.

#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

<u>AGSC Membership Attendance.</u> The membership appointment for the regional universities is still pending (attachment-#1). Sessions will continue to monitor meeting attendance (attachment-#2).

**Executive Director's Report** 

<u>AGSC/STARS 2008-09 Budget.</u> Sessions gave an update on the 2008-09 AGSC budget (attached-#5). Meehan moved for approval of the amended budget. Roach seconded. Motion passed.

AGSC/STARS 2008-09 MBO Plan. Sessions presented a status report on the MBO Plan.

**Executive Director's Objectives.** All Priority activities will be met according to the MBO Plan.

<u>AGSC Priorities.</u> There was discussion regarding the effects the budget will have on the 2008-09 AGSC Priorities. With the exception of Priority three, all priorities should be met. Since Priority three calls for strengthened communication of the STARS program with students, administrators, faculty, parents, legislators, and the general public, activities associated with this priority have been severely affected by the budget cuts. For purposes of planning and budgeting for the next fiscal year, the AGSC requested that Sessions provide the AGSC with a summary of activities accomplished and those activities that were planned for but not implemented in the areas of Priority three at the July meeting.

<u>AGSC/STARS 2009-10 Budget.</u> Sessions pointed out that new computer equipment (server) must be included and factored into next year's budget.

**<u>STARS Usage Reports.</u>** Sessions reported that the current usage reports and the two-year CAPPS report are posted on the STARS website (copy attached-#3). Specific institutional requests can be made to the STARS office.

<u>Oral Communication Request.</u> There was discussion regarding a request from Dr. Richard Emanuel, ASU, to include descriptive language in Area II regarding Oral Communication: "Because effective oral communication skills are essential in a democratic society in this information age, where practical, an oral communication course should be one of the Humanities courses selected to fulfill Area II requirements." A copy of request is attached-#6.

After discussion, the AGSC agreed that the current structure used to list courses in Area II is sufficient and that no additional language is needed.

#### ACADEMIC COMMITTEES

**<u>Ratification of Templates.</u>** Sessions presented the following institutional specific template for ratification recommended by the Chief Academic Officers (copy attached - #4):

• Interpreter Training Program(TU)

After discussion regarding several changes to the Interpreter Training Program (TU) template, Glaze moved for ratification with changes in the Literature requirement. Courses in Area V will be listed and the word "must" deleted. Roach seconded. Motion passed.

<u>OTHER ISSUES</u>: HB485 (Regular Session 2009) which proposes an electronic common admission application form to be used at two and four-year institutions in the state, was distributed for information purposes (copy attached-#7).
