Subcommittee Report/Updates.

- a) Meta-Majors- General Education Sub-Committee Report/Update Dr. Coleman presented a sub-committee update on the meta-majors concept. The committee will be meeting next week to discuss the structure around the potential redesign for STARS and to clearly layout parameters needed to be in place. Also, the subcommittee will test out different models for feasibility.
- b) Math Requirement/Pathways Sub-Committee Report/Update
 Dr. Good presented a PowerPoint presentation for their sub-committee report. Dr.
 W. Gary Martin spoke about STAMP which is a state taskforce that focus on connecting the work being done by K-12 math pathways and higher education math courses.

- c) AP Credit Sub-Committee Report/Update

Dr. Israel presented a sub-committee update on whether to recommend an AP credit score of a three (3) for all courses across the state. The sub-committee recommends to encourage all the institutions to make the AP credit scores a three (3) but the setting needs to happen at the institution level. The sub-committee recommends for the role of the AGSC is to make the scores transparent as possible as the student moves from one institution to another.

d) ACHIEVE Conference Sub-Committee Report/Update

Dr. Arrington presented a subcommittee update for the next ACHIEVE Conference. The dates proposed are March 3-4, 2021. It will be a virtual conference. They are working on a theme and possible speakers for the conference.

AGSC/STARS New Website Report/Update

Mike Malley gave an overview of how the current system will work under the new website. He demonstrated on the website.

Retirement Announcement

Dr. Cederholm announced her retirement and therefore she's resigning as chair of the committee. Dr. Sessions informed the committee that in the past the Vice Chair finished the Chair term and a new Vice-chair was nominated.
