

ESTABLISHING PRIORITIES FOR 2026-2027



As we look ahead to the next year of AGSC and Alabama Transfers, we have established the following priorities and goals to guide our work, strengthen our statewide transfer efforts, and improve the transfer experience for students across Alabama.

Articulation and General Studies Committee Priorities

- Advance the General Studies Curriculum Review through updated Area I–IV naming, continued subcommittee work, and stakeholder engagement.
- Strengthen statewide AP credit and transfer policies by expanding credit opportunities and improving transfer practices of these type courses.
- In accordance with the Alabama Numeracy Act, implement approved elementary and early childhood education curriculum changes at four-year institutions and update Alabama Transfers Guides accordingly.
- Complete EdVisorly Pilot Project Phase 1, advance and evaluate Phase 2, and begin to prepare for possible statewide rollout if successful.

Alabama Transfers Staff Priorities

- Continue enhancing the Alabama Transfers website by expanding its services and ensuring the entire site achieves full ADA compliance by April 2027.
- Complete Phase 1 of the EdVisorly Pilot Project, advance and evaluate Phase 2, and, if successful, begin Phase 3 planning for a statewide rollout to all Alabama public higher education institutions.
- Continue collaborate with university registrars to conduct annual reviews and updates of transfer course equivalencies.
- Continue promoting Alabama Transfers and increasing awareness of AGSC initiatives.
- Support AGSC subcommittees in advancing their ongoing priorities and projects.
