# MINUTES OF MEETING Annual Review and Planning Session July 13, 2023 - 9:30 AM

**CALL TO ORDER**: The planning session of the Articulation and General Studies Committee (AGSC) was called to order by Dr. Bruce Crawford at 9:30 a.m.

**WELCOME FROM UAB**: Dr. Eva Lewis welcomed members and guests on behalf of Dr. Watts to UAB for the meeting.

**ROLL CALL**: Dr. Crawford asked Jacinta Whitehurst to call the roll to have a record of members present even though no voting would take place at this planning meeting.

**WELCOME & RECOGNIZE GUESTS:** Dr. Crawford suggested everyone introduce themselves, including guests, at the meeting.

<u>PRESENTATION DRAFT OF 2022-2023 ANNUAL REPORT</u>. Dr. Keith Sessions presented an overview of the first draft of the 2022-2023 Annual Report. He discussed the transition to the new name *Alabama Transfers*. A copy of the 2022-2023 Annual Report is available by request.

**2022-23 Priority 1**: Dr. Lewis gave a review of the General Studies Core Sub-Committee Priority Information listed in the annual report. She discussed the summary of responses from the survey that was sent to the institutions, which was presented at a previous AGSC meeting. She mentioned the request for feedback on the three options presented at a previous meeting to move forward with the potential restructuring of the state guidelines only yielded three responses.

Dr. Lewis gave an update on the University of Alabama's General Education Redesign meeting.

<u>2023-23 Priority 2</u>: Dr. Sessions gave a review of the Achieve Conference priority for which the host institution going forward will be allowed to retain the remaining funds from the Achieve Conference for scholarships. He also mentioned the University of South Alabama, along with Coastal Alabama Community College, will host the next Achieve Conference.

- **2022-23 Priority 3**: Dr. Sessions gave a review of the Area Academic Committees and the Professional Academic Committees priority. He mentioned the goal is to get these committees more re-engaged and update the list of memberships.
- **2022-23 Priority 4**: Dr. Calhoun gave a review of the ACCS approval for possible mathematical science courses that meet the new Math Pathways guidelines priority. She discussed the committee's goal is to make the non-STEM majors' course a quantitative reasoning thinking course. Dr. Sessions mentioned he is going to send an email to the four-year institutions' points of contact to check to see if any quantitative reasoning courses for non-STEM students are being actively worked on at the institutions.
- Dr. Lewis discussed a new course at UA developed for non-STEM majors that is being tested at the institution currently.
- Dr. Sessions stated statistics is an approved course for Area III for non-STEM majors. He also mentioned he will have a location on the website to share any information from institutions in regards to new mathematic reasoning courses.
- **2022-23 Priority 5**: Dr. Sessions gave a review of the ACCS and community colleges' increase usage of the transfer guide system priority.
- <u>2022-23 Priority 6:</u> Dr. Sessions gave a review of the launch of the new Alabama transfers website, provide training, and increase rebranding/marketing efforts among all constituents. Dr. Sessions mentioned the UA staff who helped with the new website: Jay Warner, Mike Malley, Brandi Stacey, Nathan Bray, and Dr. Steve Katsinas. Dr. Katsinas briefly spoke about the previous evaluations in 2002-03 and 2015-16, and the recommendations to change Area V as well as the use of mobile technology. He also recognized the previous Provost Whitaker, Charles Nash, current Provost Dalton, Brandi Stacey, and Mike Malley for their support of the new website. Dr. Sessions demonstrated some guide features on the new website.
- <u>2022-23 Priority 7</u>: To work with the Alabama Association of Independent Colleges and Universities to discuss ways we can link students to their articulation agreements and course equivalency information from the current Alabama transfers website priority. Dr. Sessions discussed a willingness to help with consulting or guiding them in their effort.
- <u>2022-23 Priority 8</u>: To determine AGSC's role in ensuring transferability of credit awarded for prior learning priority. Dr. McGill discussed to what degree AGSC should be involved in credit for prior learning. The recommendation was for AGSC staff to be engaged with two-year and four-year institutional representatives to complete course to course equivalency tables that include the most common PLA credits and identify differences in how these credits are assessed across institutions.
- Dr. Lewis discussed with the committee suggestions for the goals and priorities to focus on in the upcoming 2023-2024 year. The committee suggested to carryover some priorities from 2022-2023 year and add additional priorities listed below:
  - To continue the ACHIEVE conference;
  - To continue the Alabama Transfer website:
  - CLEP and AP analysis:

- Work with Alabama Transfers staff to develop and recommend a succession plan;
- Continue General Studies Core Sub-Committee to generate five questions requiring what general ed studies should be in 5 years and following through on the recommendations; and
- Address sequence issues in Area II and IV (Literature and History).

Dr. Sessions mentioned he asked for an increase in the AGSC budget, which was approved. He would like to use the increase of funds to hire additional staff and help with training, education, marketing, and social media.

**OUTGOING CHAIR RECOGNITION:** Dr. Sessions presented Dr. Crawford a plaque recognizing his service as the Chair of the Committee. Dr. Crawford thanked everyone.

Dr. Crawford adjourned the Annual Review and Planning Session with a prayer at 12:19 p.m. The business meeting will reconvene at 1:30 p.m.

He thanked Dr. Wehlburg, Chair of the Planning Committee, and Dr. Coleman, Vice-Chair, for agreeing to serve for the next Achieve Conference. He also wanted to thank Mike Malley for his work with the website and rebranding.

- Continue to market and promote the Alabama Transfers program in order to improve/increase system usage.

#### The AGSC will:

- Host the 6th Annual Achieve Conference.
- Evaluate and analyze CLEP and AP in an effort to create a useful crosswalk matrix to bring attention to and address possible issues or problems.
- Continue work of General Studies Core Sub-Committee with a goal of addressing the following:
  - Identify what general studies should look like in five years;
  - o Identify the mission of general studies in Alabama; and
  - Identify and address the challenges and/or barriers that prevent action on revisioning the general studies core.
- Address sequencing issues in Areas II and IV (Literature and History).
- Work with Alabama Transfers staff to develop and recommend a succession plan.

Dr. Arrington moved to accept the recommendation of approval of the AGSC priorities and goals for 2023-24. Dr. Fulmer seconded. Motion passed.

A lengthy discussion occurred, regarding the limitation of courses in Area II. Dr. Coleman suggested Dr. Sessions clarify with the institution if any Fine Arts courses will be acceptable in Area II, and if any changes are made, it can be done at a later date.

Dr. Coleman moved for ratification of template. Dr. Calhoun seconded. Motion passed.

## Sports Management & Recreation Studies - 31.0101 (USA Only)

Dr. Coleman moved for ratification of template. Dr. Arrington seconded. Motion passed.

#### ACHIEVE CONFERENCE PLANNING SUB-COMMITTEE UPDATE

Dr. Sessions stated he will meet with the committee to finalize dates and hotel room blocks.

### GEN ED CORE REVIEW SUB-COMMITTEE UPDATE

Dr. Lewis recapped updates from planning meeting. She discussed a decision needed for committee structure and subcommittees that need to be appointed within this committee.

Dr. Crawford discussed developing a resolution to recognize the University of Alabama for appreciation of their services rendered.

Dr. Coleman moved to develop a resolution recognizing Dr. Katsinas and the leadership at UA for their support. Dr. Crawford seconded. Motion passed.

Dr. Sessions mentioned in his proposed budget plan to possibly contract Mike Malley for continued help on ongoing projects and to help offset some cost to UA.

Dr. Lewis discussed creating a working group to help with a succession plan. The working group will be Dr. McGill, Dr. Crawford, Dr. Johnson, and Dr. Sessions.

Dr. Fulmer moved with the recommendation to create an adhoc working group to help with a succession plan. Dr. Arrington seconded. Motion passed.

Dr. Coleman asked if anyone was interested in being on a panel for a session at the Achieve Conference on the curricula tension of native students and transfer students.
