CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting of the Articulation and General Studies Committee was called to order at 2:02 p.m. A quorum was determined by roll call of members present.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA: Dr. Fulmer moved for the adoption of the agenda. Dr. Crawford seconded. The agenda was adopted.
INTRODUCTIONS OF NEW MEMBERS AND GUEST: Dr. Sessions introduced Dr. Susan McGurk, College Board and Dr. Fergus, Auburn University who were present for the virtual meeting.
APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Dr. Good moved for the approval of the October 20, 2020 minutes. Dr. Coleman seconded. Minutes were approved.

Nomination and Election of Vice-Chair (Two-Year Member).

Dr. Sessions stated the Vice-Chair will serve the remainder of this term and if they wish, they can serve next year also. Dr. Crawford recommended Ms. Jackie Screws for Vice Chair for AGSC committee. She was not present, so it will be voted on at the next meeting.

Course Approvals. Dr. Sessions presented the following course proposals recommended for approval:

<u>Jacksonville State University</u> SY 223 – Social Problems (3 SH)-Area IV

Dr. Good moved to accept the new course submitted by Jacksonville State University. Dr. Petty seconded. Motion passed.

Templates for Ratification. Dr. Sessions presented for discussion only the following:

<u>Proposal for Updates/Changes to Engineering STARS Guide Proposal for</u> <u>Updates/Changes to Engineering STARS Guide</u> Dr. Fergus presented the proposed updates and changes to the Engineering STARS guide. Dr. Sessions created a new template for each major in engineering with the proposed changes in Area II and Area V. A handout of the proposed changes is available upon request.

Subcommittee Report/Updates.

a) Meta-Majors- General Education Sub-Committee Report/Update

Dr. Lewis presented a sub-committee update;

- Discussed the pros and cons of the current AGSC system.
- Courses not transferring.

- Pros and Cons of applying meta majors to the core curriculum.
- Agreement on making some modifications to the presentation of the degree majors in the STARS guide on the website.
- Potentially adopting a core of 30 hours for General Ed and applying 11 hours to the meta majors.
- Reducing the number of transfer guides.
- b) Math Requirement/Pathways Sub-Committee Report/Update Dr. Good presented an update from their sub-committee. She discussed the formation of a new group called Alabama Gateway Math Options. They will meet every other week to construct new syllabi materials for at least one new option by the end of the semester.
- c) AP Credit Sub-Committee Recommendation (Oct 2020) Dr. Sessions recommended that the committee move forward with the committee recommendation to make the AP credit scores a three (3) and ensure that institutions clearly report their AP credit awarding thresholds on their website. Dr. Sessions objective is to have the AGSC Chair write the recommendation to present to the Chief Academic Officers to review. Dr. Israel mentioned the Chief Academic Officer Chair has received a copy of the recommendation.

The committee decided that Dr. Arrington will write a formal letter to go with the recommendation and Dr. Edwards will present it to the Chief Academic Officers Chair to vote on at their next meeting.

Ms. Susan McGurk spoke briefly about her work with the College Board. She presented data from previous years on Alabama AP qualifying scores for credit.

d) ACHIEVE Conference Sub-Committee Report/Update

Dr. Arrington presented a subcommittee update for the next ACHIEVE Conference. The dates are March 3-4, 2021. It will be a virtual conference. The theme is Charting the Path Ahead: Providing Opportunities for Transfer Student Success Amid a Pandemic. Dr. Sessions briefly gave an overview of the conference website.

AGSC/STARS New Website Report/Update.

Mike Malley gave an update on the new website. He stated they will be hosting a series of workshops to demonstrate the various aspects of the website.

Request to replace AREA Academic Committee Members whose terms have ended in 2020.

Dr. Sessions stated that there are some AREA Academic Committee members who have to be replaced due to their term ending. In Area I and Area II, two 4-year members and two 2-year members need to be replaced. In Area III, one 4-year member and two 2-year members need to be replaced. In Area IV, two 4-year members and two 2-year members need to be replaced. He mentioned Dr. Edwards and Dr. Fricks are working on the replacements.

Other announcements or issues for discussion or vote.

Dr. Sessions mentioned as an information item the current usage reports are about the same.
